The South Bendigo Athletic Club commenced their 2011 Winter Cross Country Season on Saturday afternoon with 4 races being held at Victa Road East Bendigo in ideal conditions.

More than 50 runners competed on the day with 3 of the 4 winners having their first race start in a South Bendigo Athletic Club cross country event.




