

In 2007 he began his role as Canteen Manager, a role that he loved and held when he passed. He always made sure the Kettle was hot, and offered anyone and everyone any hot drink he could possibly supply.

His role as canteen manager, Committee member and overall club helper was such that in 2010 he was awarded Best Club Contributor.

Peter ran his last 1500m race on the 23rd of April 2016 at Miller's Flat, a race that also featured Jess and Peter Jnr, the two youngest of his three children. Even after this race he continued to be a presence at the club until his sudden passing on Christmas morning 2016.

The Inaugural Peter Curtis Snr Memorial race was held at Atlas Rd, Peter's "home ground", on what would have been his 62nd Birthday.


